Baldwin's Ovation of Shame

Peter Theron, candidate for Wisconsin's Second Congressional District, reacted to the disgraceful Democrat ovation during the Thursday May 20th address to a joint session of Congress by Felipe Calderón, the president of Mexico. After he tongue-lashed Arizona for daring to defend itself against invasion by Mexican illegal aliens, Congresswoman Tammy Baldwin (D-WI) and the rest of the Democrats gave Calderón a standing ovation. In National Review Online, Andrew McCarthy described the scene thusly, "Make no mistake: In the Congress of the United States on Thursday, it was a hostile Mexico against a besieged Arizona. They have weakened America and encouraged aggression against us. If their fecklessness is left uncorrected, we will rue this ovation."
